ITEM to the eighth article the Jury Saieth what Lands Tenements Leases Rents Services eschats or other p(ro)fitts and Comision of Retayned from His Matie's or escheated or forfeited within the said Mannor more then hath been Jury knoweth not.

ITEM to the [xth] article the Jury doth say that out of the wood afore named in Edward Heardman and Thomas Hardman, theire gounds these tress hereafter specified have been taken viz; Richard Chadwicke late of Spotland hath had 40 or thereabouts, James Chadwicke 20 ould Mr. Midgley Vicar of Pachdall six, James Milnes of the Lume head five, Roger Taylor one \*\*Tark, Joseph Leigh three, Robert Halwas one, & James Shepherd hath had much of the tymber that hee builded his house with.

ITEM that Edmund Scolfeld of Stake Hill printer parker parker parker with a divers trees out of that parte of the ould ("of his owne" crossed through) Coppyhold land now in the houlding & Occupacion of James Hyll by thow many the Jury Can not tell.

Rachdall one Markett kepte in the Towne called Rachdall Towne vsual [7] every Munday, and there bee three fayres holden at Rachdall every yeere viz. one uppon the third day of May annother upon the Tuesday in Whisun weeke, and the third upon the feast day of St. Symon and St. Jude, And that the said ffayres for all things favering Cattle ar kepte in the Towne of Rachdall & the ffayres for Cattle ar kepte in the Lane goinge from Rachdall Town to Rachdall Church

And that the Toules and other Comodities arysing by the said ffayres and marketts are Receased by the Baylives of Rachdall for the tyme beinge to the use expressed by the answere to the xith article. And that it hath been used and accustomed Concerning Tolle for the Catle sould and bought within the Lymentie of Rachdall that the Buyer and the Seller being both inhabitants within the Lymentie shalbee free and pay noe toll. And if the seller or buyer be an inhabitant thother a stranger then the inhabitant is free and the stranger shall pay the halfe of the Tolle that is to say id for a beaste. And they bee both strangers then the one the one halfe thother the other halfe. And the Tolle aforesaid bee taken in Manner and forme aforesaid for Catle and Horses. And want that the Exxx Balyve of the

Liberty hath alwaies used to bee answered of the whole tolk of the Byer & the Buyer hath used to paye the one halfe thereof in his hande and the seller be abated the same.

ITEM to this said article the Jury further sayeth that there is not any leade Myne within the said Parishe to theire knowledge But that there is one Coale Myne upon the Comon Called ffeatherteame Lying about the Crooke in Hundersffeld in the holding of Sir John Byron his ffarmer assignee or assigns but what tytle the said Sir John holdeth the same the Jury knoweth not. Also one other Colemyne in Trough in Spotland in the holding of Margarett Belfeild.

Also that there is one lytle Cole Myne upon Browne Wardle in the holding of the said Sir John, ffarmer, assigner or assignes, but by what tytle the said Sir John holdeth the same or what is the yearly value thereof the Jury knoweth not.

Also there is one other Cole Myne uppon the Comon in Butterworth in the holding of the said Sir John or his ffermor assigne or assignes but what tytle the said Sir John holdeth the same or what is the yearly value the Jury knoweth hot.

ITEM one other Colemyne in Trough in Spotland in the houlding of John Hoyle.

Also there is one other Colemyne Mycherdyne Clough in Walsder in the occupacion of Sayvill Radecliffe Esquyer his assigne or assignes but by what tytle or what is the yeerely value the Jury knoweth not,

ITEM further that there are within the said Parishe these Quaryes of Stone hereafter named viz; one Quarye upon Brownewardle, one other quary upon Middle Hill, one other Quarry upon ffarcett Moss, besyde that in sundry places of the said List there is Rocke & Quarryes of ffreestone. Which ffreestone hath beene usually gotten fetched and used by the inhabitants & others from the Comons and Waste grounds without interupcion to the knowledge and Remembrance of this Jury, Other Cohlls Maynes Quarries of Stone or other Mynes then these above named saving those that are within the severall Inheritances of the ffreehoulders within the said Parishe the Jury knoweth nohe.

ITEM to the eleventh article the Jury saith that there is a Court Leet twyse in the yeare holden and kept within the said Parish And that there is and hath beene tyme out of mynd an other Court kept within the said parishe by the Steward for the tyme being sometymes ffoure tymes yearely some tymes fyve tymes some tymes sixe tymes and sometymes every mothe im the yeares as yt pleased the Steward of the said parishe And that the said Courtes have alwayes beene kepte in Rachdall Towne sometymes in the howse sometymes in an other howse as the Steward and the howseholder could agree, but whether as belonginge to the said market

or by what tytle the Jury can nott tell. But saith that all the ffreehoulders within the said parishe bee called as suitors to appear at the said leete court but the freeholders not beene called to appeare at the other Courtes, but the freeholders

Tenants for yeares for Lyffe or at will, and that the p(ro)fitts arysinge at the said Courts Leet are the ffynes & Amerciants assessed at the same Courte upon such and offenders as have offended in anie Article inquirable in the said Leet. And that the profittes which aryse out of the other Courtes bee as followeth viz: uppon every Deft chead which appeareth not at the first distresse iiii at the seacond vid and for his Condemnacon iii.

And the Jufy saith that Sir John Byron Knight and his Ancestors and those whose estate hee in the Baliwicke of Rachdall have duringe the tyme of these Jurors Remembrancem by them selves or their Deputies for the tyme beinge usually had and Receyved to their only use and behalfe all maner of fynes amerciants p(er)quisites of Courts wayvesestrayes ffelons goods and other Casualties Tolles and stallage within the said parishe of Rachdall as appertaininge and belonginge to the said office of Baÿliwicke, and hath yelded and payed to the Kings Ma<sup>tie</sup>  $xx^{j_1s}$  wiii yearely for the same for xxxx anie thinge the Jury knoweth to the Contrarie. And further saith that the said Sir John Byron Claymeth to have the servinge of all the Kinge's Arocesse within the said Libertie and the fee meered. due for the same and hath had the same but not without some Interuption, for some tymes the Sherriffes of the Shire by their balyffes errante have served process within the said Libertie and receyved the fee therof. And they further saye that the King's MaxXXX Leete and the Liberties & Royallties afforesaid have extended through the marishe of Rachdall and fee doe yet for anything the Jury knoweth to the Contrarie. But what is or hathbeene the said ffgines amerciaments & pritts of the said Courte the Jury can not tell but refer them selves in that respect to the Courte Rolles of the same Mannor Amd what hath beene the yearly value of other the profitts mentioned in this Article the Jury knoweth not saveing that Sir John Byron & his officers or servants or deputies together with Mr Anderton of Lostocke & his officers or servants have agreed within this Twelve months last paste to Cease upon the goods of one Jane Butterworth lately attaynted of ffelony which goods dold amount to the value of one Hundmerth pounds or above but what authoritie or Commission from His Matie or agreement themselves the said Mr. Anderton or his officers soe did the Jury knoweth not.

AR12 ITEM to the 12th article the Jury doth say that there is no mylne belonginge to His Matie within the said Parishe to their knowledge.

ITEM to the 13th article the Jury doth saie that they Exempts Cannot conveniently soe distinguish Betweene the arable land Medow & pasture as is required in the said article by reason that the moste parte of the said Coppinould land excepting such as Lyeth uppon or neere the heights of the Montaynes which much of it is Heathie Mossie and Stony Land & unfithfor husbandry is used for all the said purposes of plowing mowinge and pasturing as occasion & necessitie doth urge the occupyers therof. And further for the valuacon therof considering the Charges which the inhabitants have beene at for the enclosing manuring & husbanding thereof ( being the most of land improved from off the Comons and Wastes all which Charges is meant in the said article should bee deducted out the valuaçon thereof as i Jury understandeth) They say that notwithstanding the ffynes Rents etc. Reserved of Undertenants the value thereof is by estimacon as followeth VIZ:
