Re: Private Robert Fletcher 45668 11<sup>th</sup> Batn. Lancashire Fusiliers

Died 16<sup>th</sup> April 1918 Tournai

Dear Sir,

The above person was my Grandfather who was badly wounded at Mont de Lille ,near Ballieul, on the 14<sup>th</sup> April 1918 during the British retreat. He was left behind with other badly wounded men along with two orderlies to be taken prisoner by the Germans.

He was taken by the Germans to the old Academie des Beaux-Arts in Tournai in the Rue de l'Hopital Notre Dame which I believe had been made into a hospital for Allied soldiers. He died two days later on the 16<sup>th</sup> April 1918 of his wounds. He is buried in the Southern Cemetery on the Ere Rd in the Military section. I have visited both places quite a few times in the last 30 years.

Recently, with the help of the Lancashire Fusiliers and a friend in the Ypres Museum I have traced all his movements from going to France in Sept 1915 to his being wounded in 1918. He fought at the Somme and around Ypres and At Messines Ridge.

I was wondering if any of your records could help me with his last two days at Tournai. Especially the following.

1] What wounds did he die from? I have conflicting reports of a head and a bayonet wound.

2] Was he treated by Belgian Nuns, as I believe some Allied soldiers were.?

I am enclosing some letters from the time including one from yourselves


Any small info from this time would be appreciated so that I can complete my research and I would cover any costs involved.


